We currently have a lot of initiatives running. This past week we just confirmed our Z.P.G.A. POTRAZ radio license, meaning that the 37 members that have opted to use our license will not face any issues at police road blocks. It may seem like a small and easy enough task, but with members away in the field, sometimes with no, or poor connectivity getting information from them takes time. Building relationships with government departments has proven to be fruitful with POTRAZ licensing, up to and including 2024.

We have just sent out the schedules for our First Aid Training, beginning in July ending in September. As always we encourage all members to support this initiative, not only from a legal perspective but also from a place of having comfort in the knowledge that should something go wrong it can be dealt with.

Insurance is another area that we have tackled over the last few weeks, we always recommend and suggest all members need to be fully paid up in terms of medical insurance so that they are covered in the event of an accident and more importantly don't leave family members stranded because they are unable to work. ## Protecting our License, Protecting our Jobs

There are many rules surrounding Professional Guiding & Hunting in Zimbabwe. One that stands out and is clear "All Zimbabwean guides license holders either have to have a Zimbabwean passport or have a permanent residence stamp/sticker within their passports." This is one of the first rules we learn when sitting our LPH exams, and only if this criteria is met will licenses be issued through National Parks, enabling license holders to conduct safaris within Zimbabwe.

All too often we see individuals from neighbouring countries either hunting or guiding, which for many of us is an annoyance, but in fact is actually illegal.

Recently there have been a number of cases where medics, registered in our neighbouring countries have been employed to accompany safaris in Zimbabwe for purposes of administering medical care should it be required. Just as with our Guides licenses, LPH's, Professional Guides and Hunters, our Zimbabwean Medics are also protected by similar laws and rules. It is illegal for a Medic registered outside of the country to practice for reward and be employed within Zimbabwe.

## Matusadona National Park - Zimbabwe

Matusadona National Park gets its name from the rolling Matusadona hills that form part of its water-rich landscape. Flanked by Lake Kariba in the north, and two perennial rivers, the Ume and the Sanyati, this remote and rugged park is the first in Zimbabwe to fall under the African Parks mandate. Proclaimed a National Park in 1975, it was once a conservation stronghold for African elephant and black rhino, and a sought-after tourism destination. But over the years, financial resources slowly diminished and poor management impacted the parks' wildlife. Limited road networks and manpower left some areas entirely unpatrolled resulting in rampant poaching, which virtually eliminated the black rhino population and severely reduced the elephant population. While Matusadona's wildlife has suffered, fortunately its integrity as a wilderness landscape has remained undiminished, providing an exceptional opportunity for this park to be restored.

African Parks, in partnership with the Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Management Authority (Zimparks), signed a 20-year agreement to manage Matusadona National Park in November, 2019. At 1,470 km2, this unique landscape presents enormous potential for both wildlife and tourism. The lush landscape, consisting of undulating hills that descend to flat grasslands, forms important habitat for a large diversity of savannah and woodland species. Apart from over 240 bird species, a healthy variety of mammal species still occur within Matusadona, including lion, buffalo, elephant, waterbuck and impala. The Lake's shoreline is guarded by a kilometer-wide, iconic drowned forest, and when combined with the park's unique vegetation, a unique tourism potential through game viewing, fishing and other lake and park activities is offered.

Although this spectacular park is fraught with challenges, African Parks' careful management in collaboration with Zimparks, offers Matusadona the potential to become Zimbabwe's premier elephant and black rhino sanctuary once again. African Parks has begun to revive Matusadona through a foundation of good governance, an effective law enforcement strategy, community engagement initiatives, tourism and restoring wildlife populations through reintroductions of indigenous wildlife.

#### Matusadona Highlights

- In November 2019, African Parks and the Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Management Authority (Zimparks) signed a 20-year agreement to restore, develop and manage Matusadona National Park.
- One of Matusadona's most compelling features is its diverse bird life with over 240 species being recorded in the park.
- In 2021, 223 Burchell's zebra were translocated to the park to boost game populations. Ten elephants were collared, providing valuable information for better protection. And a hippo survey identified over 2,100 hippos along the Matusadona shoreline an increase from approximately 250 animals in the early 1980s.
- Matusadona National Park holds extraordinary potential to become a leading safari tourism destination
  offering exceptional game viewing from both land and the lake, creating much needed revenue for
  surrounding communities.

  - A retest on the drivers license class you hold valid 5 years
  - Make sure you pop into your local VID and ensure you are compliant remember insurance will not pay out if you fall short of the law
- Weapons license
  - Have you checked your weapons license validity? Remember these are valid for 3
    years. If you require assistance in sorting these Karel Strydom will assist
- First Aid certificate
  - Being current and up to date is not only the right thing to do but it is a legal requirement. The Z.P.G.A. has partnered with ACE Air and Ambulance to bring you the best First Aid course available at reasonable prices
- Evacuation cover
  - ACE Air and Ambulance have you covered from as little as US\$5 per month, or US\$60 per year - can you seriously afford not to be covered?
- Medical Insurance/Aid
  - The Z.P.G.A. has partnered with MedNet whom will assist you through the many different policies and providers and come up with the best plan for you







## **Hunting - Let's look at it differently?** By Paul Stones

As Hunters, we win small battles, but all that happens is that the battlefield moves and we start all over again, at massive cost, in which we have in reality merely bought time before execution and nothing else.

We are facing a moment of truth today that we might not wish to admit and that is we need to change OUR offering in all this. The constant fight to bring home the "hubris" of the hunt, in many ways undermines the real reason why we say we hunt. "The experience, the wild places, the adventure that is the destiny of what we do".

When we say that "import bans" are the end, we are weak, we are admitting what the "antis" have long said, that it is about the "trophy" and not much else.

Education of the youth is where we win the fight long term. Showing kids a video of a hunting experience far outweighs a dead head on a wall. The visuals, sounds and overall picture painted in film creates that what you want to carry across. A dead head is exactly that, a dead head. There is no context for the child.

We need to sell experience, adventure and not "trophy" animals. We need to hunt for the real reason we hunt, and if we cannot bring something other than a memory home, we should be good with that.

I do not doubt this mindset will be met by many as a "cop out". I am an outfitter and I need clients. As the years go by, I have more and more that have no interest in the export but wish to spend the money they would have spent on export, taxidermy etc. on another trip with me.

What is bizarre is the fact that that many of those that spurred us into hunting trips, Selous, Blixen, Manners, et al. had little to no interest in heads on walls, but merely adventured and lived life to the full. That is what we will win, as no one can ever stop us hunting.

We need to spend the millions we do spend fighting monthly battlefields on our youth and changing perception on what a hunt is actually about.
